- Annual Whole Child Needs Assessment for North Carolina Youth
- 20 Indicators of Wellness
- ▶ 4 Domains:
 - Health
 - Youth Behavior and Safety
 - **▶** Education
 - Economic Development



Ranking Methodology



Indicator Ranking

- Ordered counties from highest to lowest or lowest to highest, depending on category
- Ranked countiesI-100

Domain Ranking

- Averaged the rankings of all counties from each of the five indicators
- Ranked counties I-100 based on those averages

Overall Ranking

- Averaged the ranking of all 20 indicators for each county
- Ranked counties I-100 based on those averages



Overall Rankings





- QUARTILE 1 Counties Ranked 1-25
- QUARTILE 2 Counties Ranked 26-50
- QUARTILE 3 Counties Ranked 51-75
- QUARTILE 4 Counties Ranked 76-100

Example of County Analysis: Guilford County - 25

- Health: 17
 - ▶ Teen Pregnancy: 15
 - Number of Physicians: 12
 - Child Fatality: 73
 - Child Food Insecurity: 26
 - Child Obesity: 36
- Youth Behavior & Safety: 55
 - Juvenile Delinquency: 70
 - Short-Term Suspensions: 40
 - Detention Admissions: 83
 - Children in DSS Custody: 56
 - Child Abuse/Neglect: 12

- **Education: 20**
 - Graduation Rate: 24
 - → 3rd Grade Reading: 62
 - ▶ NC Math 1:28
 - ► ACT Composite: 23
 - Met or Exceeded Growth: 26
- Economic Development: 29
 - Household Income: 23
 - ► Child Poverty: 23
 - Unemployment: 55
 - Bachelor's Degrees: 10
 - Single Parent Households: 66



Decrease

- Craven County: 29 to 47
- Hyde County: 55 to 71

Increase

- ▶ Haywood County: 40 to 23
- ▶ Hoke County: 69 to 54
- Jackson County: 46 to 27
- McDowell County: 77 to 58
- Pamlico County: 59 to 40


